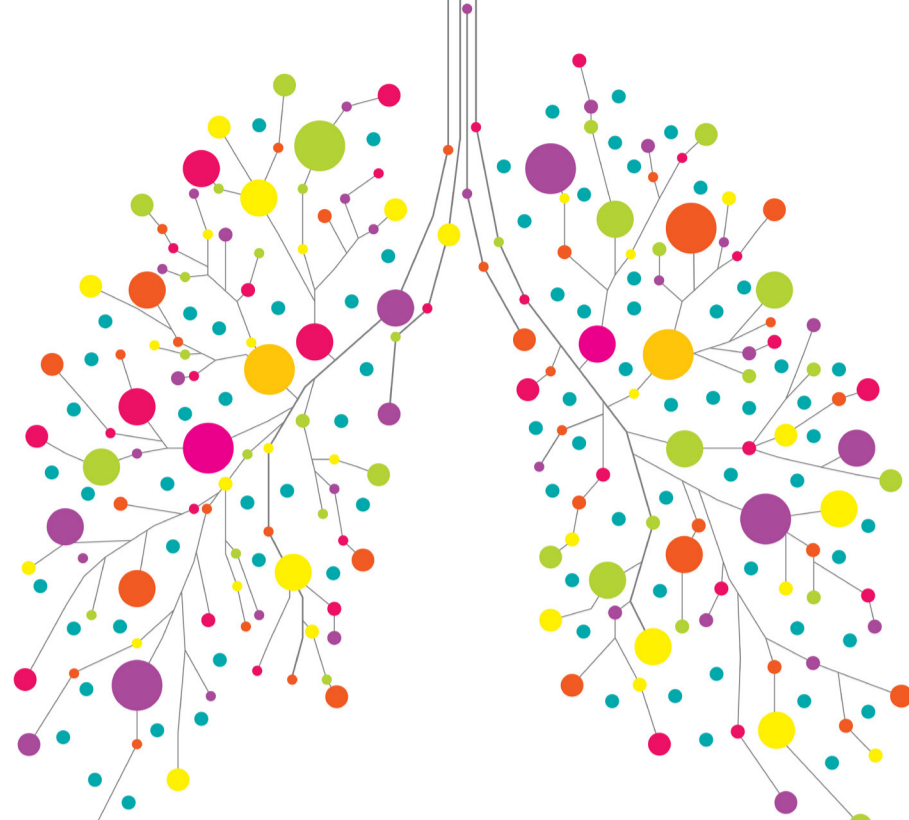

Anoro has been designed for people with COPD in mind.^{1,2} It has not one but two ingredients to help relax the airway muscles, helping to open your airways and increase the amount of air you can breathe.³

A combined treatment for COPD^{3,4}

Anoro is a combination of two medicines (umeclidinium and vilanterol), that are inhaled at the same time through a simple, easy-to-use inhaler device. Just a single puff, taken every day, can help you to breathe easier. The counter lets you know how many doses you have left.

How do you use Anoro Ellipta^{3,4}

Anoro Ellipta is a dry powder inhaler. This means it doesn't contain propellants – just your medication. There are three simple steps to help you breathe better with Anoro, Open, Inhale & Close.

Anoro Ellipta** is a Prescription Medicine for long-term regular treatment to relieve symptoms in adult patients with Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD). **Use strictly as directed. Do not take Anoro Ellipta to treat asthma or to relieve acute symptoms. Always carry your reliever inhaler. This medicine has risks and benefits.
